So we tell others about Christ, warning everyone and teaching everyone with all the wisdom God has given us. We want to present them to God, perfect in their relationship to Christ. **Colossians 1:28**

Then make me truly happy by agreeing wholeheartedly with each other, loving one another, and working together with one mind and purpose. **Phillipians 2:2**

And now, just as you accepted Christ Jesus as your Lord, you must continue to follow him. **Colossians 2:6**

You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. **Phillipians 2:5**
